English

As readers and writers, we will access our new literacy scheme – Literacy Tree. We will use high quality texts to focus our writing.

Geography

As geographers, we will be answering the question, 'What is it like to live by the coast?'. We will be exploring the seas and oceans surrounding the UK. We will also be identifying coasts in our country as well as learning about their physical features.

History

As historians, we will be answering the question, 'What is a monarch?'. We will be learning about current monarchs and monarchs from the past. We will identify features of different castles and discuss how they have changed. We will learn about William the Conqueror, including how he became the King of England and how he ruled.

Science

As scientists, we will be exploring plant growth and also making connections with plant based materials. We will be learning about the functions of seeds, bulbs, germination and light. We will also discuss the plant life-cycle and how to care for plants.

Opportunities, creativity and community

This term, the children will have the opportunity to visit the seaside. We will continue to learn Makaton. We will also take part in our sports day.

Art

As artists, we will be doing a stick transformation project. We will explore how artists use their creative skills to re-see and re-imagine the world.

Computing

As computer scientists, we will be creating media using stop motion. We will also be learning about how to read and use data.

Design Technology

As design technologists, we will learning about cooking and nutrition, more specifically learning about a balanced diet. We will explore different foods and discuss the feel, taste and smell. We will also make a wrap using a range of ingredients.

Life skills
