



## **Evidencing the impact of Primary PE and Sport Premium Funding**

### **Cookham Rise Primary School 2022/23**

In 2022/23 Cookham Rise received funding of £17,790. Of this, £2,940 was spent purchasing the Ascot and Maidenhead School Sports Partnership (A&MSSP) Active package which provides access to local inter-school competitions, CPD opportunities for staff and 12 hours of specialist coaching and advisory support.

#### **School Games**

- To create positive experiences that promote the character development of targeted young people
