

PE and School Sport Funding at Cookham Rise

Forecast 2015/16

This year our key objectives are to achieve the Silver Level Sainsbury's School Games Mark and for all PE lessons to be at least 'Good'.

Key actions to support these objectives include:

- Provide relevant and targeting CPD opportunities for staff, including teaching assistants
- PE leadership time to observe lessons and team teach with staff
- Continuing to promote inter school competition (Level 2), with the aim of giving as many of our children the opportunity to participate in a range of Sainsbury's School games format competitions;
- Encouraging more of our children to participate in extra curricula sporting clubs and activities (target - 35%);
- Continuing to develop the range of sporting clubs offered to children across KS1 and KS2;
- Continuing to develop active links with local sports clubs;
- Ensuring that **all** children continue to have access to two hours of physical education and school sport per week;
- To provide a range of playground equipment to encouraging all children to have healthy and active playtimes;
- Develop an internal tracking system for children attending extra curricula sports clubs and representing the school in inter school competitions
- Develop intra school competitions (Level 1) using our existing House system and Sainsbury's school games formats
- Foster relationships with local sports clubs

For 2015/16 the funding allocation for Cookham Rise is expected to be approx. £9000.
