## Willow 6 Summer Term 2025



### English

As readers and writers, we will study *Resist*, *Rose Blanche*, *Night Mail* and *Some Places More Than Others*. Writing opportunities will include newsletters, balanced arguments, stories, recipes, poems, biography, information leaflets and instructions.

Homework will be based upon the book *Goodnight, Mr Tom* and a choice of WW2 novels.

### History

As historians, we will learn about World War 2. Children will make inferences and deductions from photographs and evaluate the accuracy and reliability of sources. They will learn out about the causes of the Second World War, evacuation and the impact of WW2 on women's lives.

### Science

As scientists, we will continue to learn about the circulatory system and health, finding out about the job of the heart and how to stay healthy. Children will also learn about circuits, batteries and switches, before applying this knowledge in their DT project.

### Opportunities, creativity and community

Year 6 will perform the show "Rock Bottom" and take part in a residential trip to PGL. Children will also visit Maidenhead Mosque and their new secondary schools. Visitors will include the police, road safety officer, Cookham Dig, Maidenhead Heritage Centre and Wayne Dixon. Children will develop their GarageBand skills with Three.

### Art

As artists, we will create propaganda posters and think about how to turn 2d images into 3d sculptures.

### Computing

As computer scientists, we will learn about codes, hacking and the role of computing in the Second World War. Children will develop this coding skills using Scratch and Python.

### DT

As technologists, we will create model fairground rides, using pulleys and electric motors.

### French

As linguists, we will complete mini-projects, revising the language skills we have developed so far.

### Life skills

As students, we will prepare for the move to secondary skills, thinking about making new friendships and developing our organizational skills. Children will also take part in Sex and Relationships Education, learning about puberty and conception.

### Music

As musicians, we will learn about the songs of World War 2, rehearse for our Leavers' production and compose using GarageBand.

### PE

As athletes, we will take part in basketball and athletics lessons with Mr Brown and Miss Maher.

### RE

As theologians, we will consider the question, "Why is there suffering?" and think about the place of religion in today's world.
