### English

As readers and writers, we will study *The Last Bear* and *Can we Save the Tiger?* in Term 3. In Term 4, we will explore *Romeo and Juliet* and *Grimm's Fairy Tales*. Writing opportunities will include letters, posters, poetry, news articles, character descriptions, dialogue, scientific reports and narratives.

Homework will be based upon the book *Darwin's Dragons* by Lindsay Galvin.

### Geography

As geographers, we will learn about renewable and non-renewable sources of energy. We will find out about how energy is generated in different parts of the world and learn about the impact of energy creation on the environment.

### History

As historians, we will continue to learn about our local area and find out what we can discover about Cookham from primary sources including the census.

### Science

As scientists, we will learn about evolution and inheritance. We will find out about electricity and energy, making simple circuits using batteries and switches.

### Opportunities, creativity and community

This term, Willow 6 will have the opportunity to take part in Safer Internet day and a VR workshop on Climate Change. We will visit Eton College to take part in activities about climate change and evolution.

As artists, we will create our own colour installations and will explore 2d to 3d making.

### Computing

As computer scientists, we will learn about how data is transmitted through bar codes, QR codes and RFID, as well as continuing to develop our programming skills.

As technologists, we will prepare a simple, healthy meal.

### French

As linguists, we will learn to describe our houses and families.

### Life skills

As citizens, we will think about about our goals for the year ahead, being healthy and staying safe.
