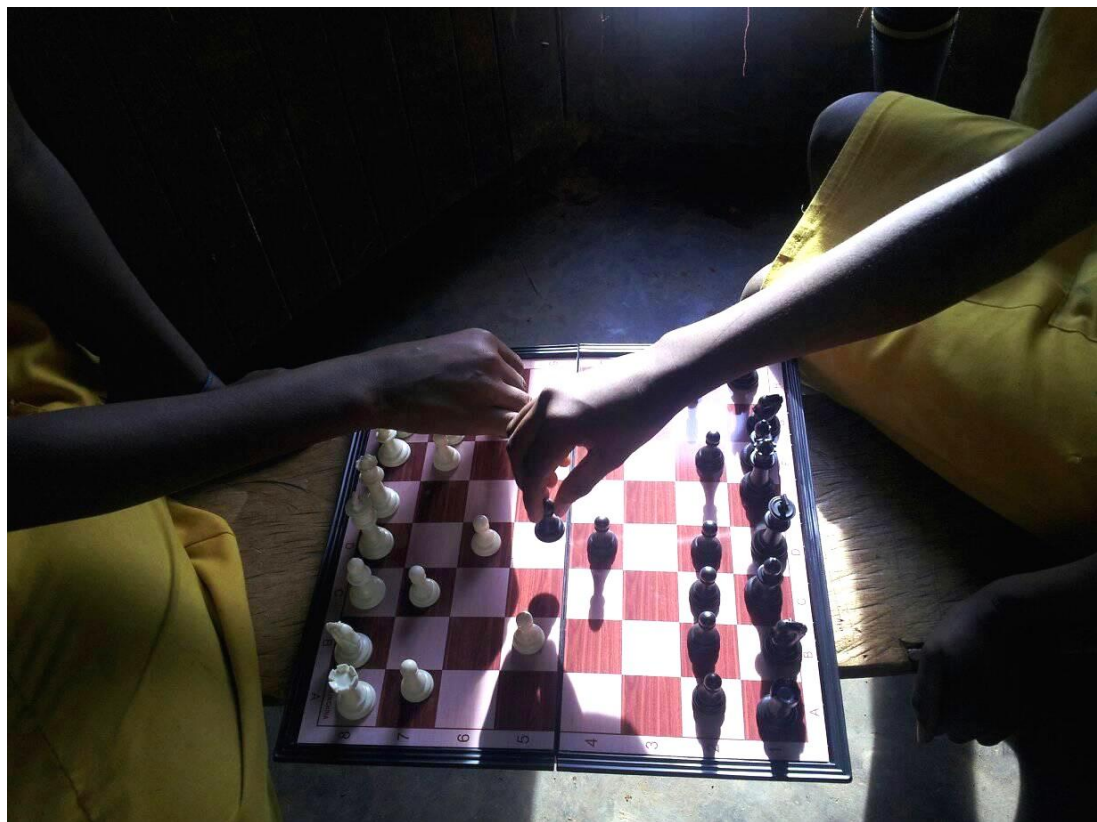

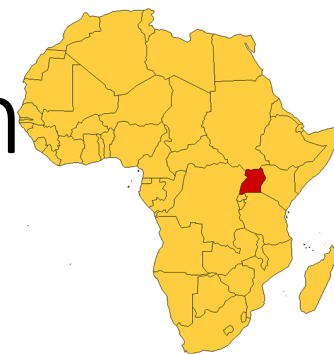

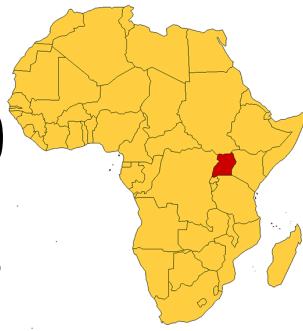


The Winners of the Colouring Competition

A childhood dream come true for Mr Nickolas!



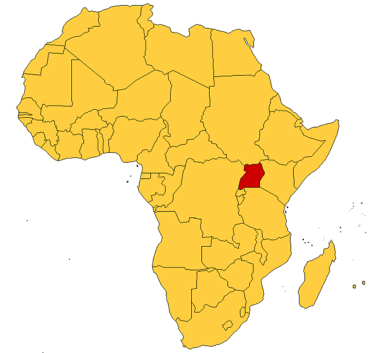
