Allocation

Allocations have been calculated on a per pupil basis, providing each mainstream school with a total of £80 for each pupil in years Reception through to Year 11.

<p>It is planned that money will be spent</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Paying for additional TA hours in KS1 to support with 1:1 phonics work (started mid October 2020) - Paying for a teacher for 1.5hrs per week in Years 1 and 2 for class teachers to deliver catch up support (started November 2020) - Paying for a teacher for 1.75hrs a week in Years 3 – 6 so that class teachers can deliver catch up support (started mid October 2020)

How will we know if Catch Up has had an impact?
<p>Children are monitored carefully through regular progress meetings (six a year) with support being put in place where appropriate, reviewed and altered as needed. All children have had targets set for reading, writing and maths for the year.</p> <p>Teachers will work with focus pupils as well as more generally with any pupils needing particular support at a particular time.</p> <p>‘Harder’ evidence such as data is used to monitor progress alongside ‘softer’ evidence such as members of staff reporting that children are feeling more confident, taking part in lessons, completing Seesaw tasks etc</p>
