**Sports Day**

We have made the decision not to go ahead with our usual sports day due to the high forecast temperatures.

We will have an hour of racing for KS2 children first thing on Friday morning when it is cooler between 9.00 and 10.00am.

This decision has been made as:

- ◆ It is harder for younger pupils to regulate their body temperature
- ◆ Years 1 and 2 classrooms don't have air conditioning and so the children will be in very warm classrooms all day
- ◆ KS2 pupils are more able to regulate their body temperatures, hydrate better than younger pupils and can share the Year 3 and 6 air conditioning more easily

Please could all children in KS2 come into school in PE kit with a hat and water bottle.

Please could they wear their green shorts or skirt and a t-shirt in their house colour (if there are any problems with this please don't worry and we can provide a band in that colour for them to wear)

Ruby—Red

Sapphire—Blue

Emerald—Green

No pupils will be made to take part if they don't want to and we won't be doing any longer track runs.

Spectators are welcome to take a seat on the field straight after drop off and we will aim to start at 9.00am.

If a weather warning is announced we would need to cancel.

Mrs Pateman and I have put sports day in the diary earlier next year—Thursday 27th May 2027 which is the day before we break up for half term (there is a training day on Friday 28th May 2027.)  
Hopefully we will have perfect weather conditions!
